

Application Guidance: Bursary for Trainees in Paediatric Dentistry

Aims:

The aim of the bursary is to facilitate trainees to attend the annual Teachers' Branch Study Day.

Budget:

The budget allocated for the bursary is proposed by the Treasurer in consultation with the Bursary Panel. The current proposal includes:

• Teachers' Branch Study Day registration fee.

Bursary Panel:

- Branch Chair
- Branch Chair Elect
- Branch Treasurer
- Branch Council Rep
- Branch SAC Rep
- 2 representatives from the CAPC

Application process:

- Submission of a completed application form is required. The application should be supported by the applicant's Educational supervisor or Training Programme Director
- Applications should be submitted to the Teachers' Branch secretary via email.
- Submission deadline: 31st March of each year preceding Teachers' Branch Study Day.

Selection criteria:

The award of the bursary will be based on the following criteria:

The applicant should:

- be a member of the BSPD
- be involved in the teaching of Paediatric Dentistry
- hold a training (or honorary training) number in Paediatric Dentistry (pre-CCST, post-CCST, ACF, or ACL)

Additional information:

- Members of the Teachers' Branch committee are ineligible to apply.
- The Bursary panel will rank the applications based on the information provided in the application form.
- The Bursary panel's decision is final.
