He is an international speaker and leads several international orthodontic postgraduate training programs.

On **Wednesday the 23rd Feb 2022 Dr. Nitha Naqvi**, revered and mightily accomplished consultant paediatric cardiologist based at the Royal Brompton Hospital will talk to us about management and care for paediatric patients with CHD. Being the current lead in paediatric echocardiography, she specialises in echocardiography, aortopathy, as well as Marfan syndrome. She also currently leads the paediatric cardiac network at RBH hospital.

The plan for the annual March Study day in 2022 will be confirmed closer to the time and with much notice as possible.

The final meeting of the year will be on **Monday the 16th May 2022** where we will combine our **AGM and the junior member's paper presentations** as our usual joint slot. Mina Vaidyanathan will be taking over the chair of the branch.
